Payments Regulations for the 2026-2027 Academic Year

This document details the payments that you will need to pay for the 2026-2027 academic year. Please note that these payments do not include health insurance. All students must be covered by Israeli health insurance and pay directly to the health insurance provider.

1. Tuition payments and campus fees

- The tuition fees are determined based on the class to which you belong (graduation year). Any transfer between classes may result in a change of tuition.
- The yearly tuition is divided into 4 payments (please see the table below).
- All students, including financial aid recipients (full and partial), **must make the first payment.**
- All payments will be made in NIS directly from your Israeli bank account.
- The exchange rate will be fixed for the entire year, based on the exchange rate on **August 15th, 2026**. This exchange rate will apply to all 4 payments.

2. Financial Aid recipients

- Financial aid is for 8 semesters if you do not have a mandatory academic program.
- If you have been selected to receive a **full financial aid package**, you will only be charged the first payment (November). Upon completion of the academic year, your Israeli bank account will be credited with the entire amount paid. If your enrollment is terminated for any reason before the end of the year, this payment will not be refunded.
- If you have been selected to receive a **partial financial aid package**, 50% of your grant will be set off against the 2nd payment, and 50% will be set off against the 4th payment.
- If at the end of the year there is a surplus in your tuition bill with the Student Accounts department, your Israeli bank account will be credited in August.

3. Termination of studies

Winter Semester:

1. If your enrollment is terminated, voluntarily or otherwise, **by** October 23rd, 2026, you will not be charged tuition for this academic year.
2. If your enrollment is terminated, voluntarily or otherwise, **by** November 5th, 2026, you will be charged the first payment (November), regardless of the reason for termination.
3. If your enrollment is terminated, voluntarily or otherwise, **after** November 5th, 2026, you will also be charged for the second payment (January), regardless of the reason for termination.

Spring Semester:

4. If your enrollment is terminated, voluntarily or otherwise, **by** March 17th, 2027, you will not be charged tuition for the spring semester.
5. If your enrollment is terminated, voluntarily or otherwise, **by** April 1st, 2027, you will be charged the third payment (April), regardless of the reason for termination.
6. If your enrollment is terminated, voluntarily or otherwise, **after** April 1st, 2027, you will also be charged for the fourth payment (June), regardless of the reason for termination.

4. Dorms and utilities

In addition to tuition payments, all students living in the Technion dorms will make their dorm payments in NIS on the 10th of every month from your Israeli bank account. Each dorm payment includes the rent for the current month and the utilities of the previous month. For example, the payment made on June 10th is the rent for June and the utilities for May.

5. Additional payments

Additional fees can be added during the academic year, for example: books, official certificates, and more, up to approximately. 300 NIS.
